ORDER

Beginning during the January 2020 Term of Court, the Court will begin posting video recordings of oral arguments on the Calendar and Docket page of the Court's website www.courtswv.gov. The following Terms of Use are hereby adopted for use regarding the video recordings of oral arguments.

Terms of Use: To make the West Virginia Judiciary more accessible to the public, video recordings of oral arguments will be made available on the Calendar and Docket page of the Court's website www.courtswv.gov as soon as time permits after each argument, unless the video recording is deemed to be confidential or otherwise inaccessible. By accessing the video recordings, the user agrees that the recordings are for informational and educational purposes only and may not be used for commercial or political purposes. Unauthorized use of the video recordings for commercial or political purposes may result in civil or criminal action against the user. Further, the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia is not a court of record for court proceedings. The video recordings do not meet the technical standard for a digital archive.

It is therefore ordered, that the Terms of Use apply to all posted video recordings of oral argument held by the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia.
