

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

SUPREME COURT OF APPEALS OF WEST VIRGINIA

RE: TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF THE HONORABLE JAMES H. YOUNG JR. AND THE HONORABLE JAMES J. ROWE TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF KANAWHA COUNTY TO PRESIDE IN THE PROCEEDING OF CASTO TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC., PLAINTIFF, VS. OMEGA FACILITY SOLUTIONS, SERVICES & SURETY, LLC, DEFENDANT, CIVIL ACTION NO. 12-C-1954

On December 27, 2012, Chief Justice Menis E. Ketchum entered an Administrative Order granting a Motion to Refer the above-styled case to the Business Court Division ("Division").

On January 14, 2013, as required by Trial Court Rule 29.07(a), the Honorable Christopher C. Wilkes, Division Chair, entered an order assigning the Honorable James H. Young Jr., a judge of the Division, to serve as the Presiding Judge in the above-styled case and the Honorable James J. Rowe, a judge of the Division, to serve as the Mediator in said case.

By letter dated January 31, 2013, pursuant to Trial Court Rule 29.07(b), the Division Chair requested that the Chief Justice enter an order authorizing Judges Young and Rowe to preside over the above-styled case in Kanawha County or any county within Business Court Region C. No party filed an objection.

The Chief Justice deems such request to be warranted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that the Honorable James H. Young Jr., be, and he hereby is, assigned to the Circuit Court of Kanawha County under the provisions of Article VIII, § 3 of the Constitution of West Virginia to serve as the Presiding Judge in the above-styled case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Honorable James J. Rowe, be, and he hereby is, assigned to the Circuit Court of Kanawha County under the provisions of Article VIII, § 3 of the Constitution of West Virginia to serve as the Mediator in the above-styled case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this ORDER be transmitted to the Division Chair, to the Central Office of the Business Court Division, and to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, which said Clerk is to provide copies of the same to all parties of record or their counsel.
