ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO JOIN IN EXISTING MASS LITIGATION

On February 18, 2020, Defendants filed a *Motion to Join in Existing Mass Litigation* (Transaction ID 64734613), seeking to join the above-styled civil action pending in the Circuit Court of Boone County, West Virginia, with *In re: Opioid Litigation*, Civil Action No. 19-C-9000, pending before the Mass Litigation Panel.
