ORDER DESIGNATING TOBACCO PERSONAL INJURY LITIGATION
FOR ELECTRONIC SERVICE ONLY

WHEREAS, the Mass Litigation Panel ("Panel") has determined that it is appropriate for IN RE: TOBACCO LITIGATION (INDIVIDUAL PERSONAL INJURY CASES) ("Tobacco Personal Injury Litigation") to be subject to electronic service ("e-service"); and

WHEREAS, the Panel anticipates that the Tobacco Personal Injury Litigation will become subject to electronic filing ("e-filing") by the end of 2009;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to West Virginia Trial Court Rule 15.02(c), the Panel **ORDERS** that all Tobacco Personal Injury Litigation will be subject to **e-service only** beginning on **August 31, 2009**, as provided in Trial Court Rule 15.01 *et seq.*


The Panel reminds the parties that registration and training for e-service using LexisNexis File & Serve is **mandatory**. If a party is not registered with LexisNexis by the August 31 Live Date, the party will not receive e-service of documents in the Tobacco Personal Injury Litigation. 
