ORDER DESIGNATING ELECTRONIC FILING AND SERVICE

The Mass Litigation Panel (“Panel”) has determined that it is appropriate for certain Asbestos Personal Injury Litigation to be subject to electronic filing and service (“e-filing and service”). Plaintiffs have provided LexisNexis, the e-service provider designated by the West Virginia Supreme Court, with a case specific service list containing all parties and cases, and any known corresponding representation for all cases in the October 2009 Asbestos Trial Group in the editable electronic spreadsheet format specified by File & Serve.

Pursuant to West Virginia Trial Court Rule 15.02(c), the Panel **ORDERS** that all cases in the October 2009 Asbestos Trial Group are subject to e-filing and service beginning on January 26, 2009, as provided in Trial Court Rule 15.01 *et seq.*

The Panel reminds the parties that, pursuant to Trial Court 15.02(b), e-filing and service shall not be used to initiate a civil action or to serve a new party with an amended complaint or a third-party complaint.

The Panel further reminds the parties that registration and training for e-filing and service is mandatory. To make arrangements for registration and training, the LexisNexis Customer Service Department may be reached at 888-529-7587.
