ORDER

On April 3, 2015, came the parties by their respective counsel and advised the Court that settlements had been reached in all cases involving The Segal Law Firm, L.C., and The Masters Law Firm. Thereafter, came the parties by their respective counsel and advised the Court that settlements had been reached in all cases in which Gordon C. Lane, Sr. is counsel.

In addition, Plaintiffs represented by Mr. Segal and Mr. Masters, advised the Court that certain settlement funds from Steve Combs, Karen Combs, Premier Pools, LLC, John Providenti and J. P. Mechanical, Inc. had been accepted in the aggregate by the Resolution Judges assigned to the Carbon Monoxide Exposure Litigation. Plaintiffs represented by Mr. Segal and Mr. Masters further advised the Court that three distinct issues remain unresolved as to those aggregate settlements, and that remand to the Resolution Judges assigned to the Carbon Monoxide Exposure Litigation would be appropriate. The three issues which remain unresolved are:

1. Which Plaintiffs are eligible for distribution of the various funds accepted in the aggregate by the Resolution Judges assigned to the Carbon Monoxide Exposure Litigation, including the Nautilus fund, taking into consideration this Court's ORDER dated January 29, 2015 [Transaction ID 56683365];
2. A fair and equitable method to distribute said funds to the appropriate Plaintiffs; and
3. A final order distributing specific amounts to specific Plaintiffs, once the foregoing issues are resolved.

The Court, having maturely considered the Plaintiffs' representations, does hereby **ORDER** the three above delineated issues **REMANDED** to the Resolution Judges assigned to the Carbon Monoxide Exposure Litigation for determination.

It is further **ORDERED** that Plaintiffs' counsel, within thirty (30) days, advise the Resolution Judges assigned to the Carbon Monoxide Exposure Litigation which Plaintiffs they deem are eligible for which aggregate settlements previously accepted by the Resolution Judges assigned to the Carbon Monoxide Exposure Litigation.
