ORDER REGARDING MOTION TO COMPEL FILED BY DEFENDANT PPG INDUSTRIES, INC. AND PLAINTIFFS' RESPONSES TO ALL OTHER PREVIOUSLY PROPOUNDED DISCOVERY

On April 18, 2011, PPG Industries, Inc. (hereinafter "PPG"), filed a *Motion to Compel Plaintiffs to Serve Answers and Responses to Defendant PPG Industries, Inc.'s First Combined Requests for Admissions, Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents and Things* (filed before electronic filing and service was implemented). On June 9, 2011, Plaintiffs filed a Response in opposition to PPG's motion (Transaction ID# 38065716). PPG filed a Reply on June 21, 2011 (Transaction ID# 38264261).

Having considered the above-referenced motion and responsive memoranda, and having conferred with one another to ensure uniformity of their decisions, as contemplated by West Virginia Trial Court Rule 26.07(a), the Court **GRANTS** PPG Industries Inc.'s motion to compel and **ORDERS** Plaintiffs to respond to PPG's *First Combined Requests for Admissions, Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents and Things* by no later than **November 15, 2011**.

Plaintiffs are notified that failure to fully respond to the discovery as herein ordered shall subject them to all sanctions, up to and including dismissal of the action, as provided in Rule 37 of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure.

Plaintiffs are further **ORDERED** to respond to any other previously served discovery requests by no later than **November 15, 2011**.

It is so **ORDERED**.

All exceptions and objections are noted and preserved for the record.
