**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR SUBMISSION
OF MEDIATION STATEMENTS ON BEHALF OF ALL PLAINTIFFS
REPRESENTED BY ATTORNEY SCOTT SEGAL**

On October 13, 2009, counsel for plaintiffs represented by attorney Scott Segal requested a two-week extension of time in which to submit the mediation statements required in the September 16, 2009, "Order Governing Mediation and Mediation Statements." There being no objection to such request by counsel for defendants, it is **ORDERED** that mediation statements for all cases in which attorney Scott Segal represents plaintiffs shall be delivered to the offices of Lead Resolution Judge Booker T. Stephens and Resolution Judges Alan D. Moats and James P. Mazzone either by hand delivery or by Federal Express, UPS or any other express mail service with tracking capability no later than **October 30, 2009**. The parties are reminded that mediation statements are confidential.

It is further **ORDERED** that mediation of all cases in which attorney Scott Segal represents plaintiffs shall be conducted **on Monday, November 16, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m. and shall continue from day to day through Wednesday, November 18, 2009, in the Circuit Court of McDowell County, West Virginia, in the Courtroom of the Honorable Booker T. Stephens**, assigned by the Mass Litigation Panel as Lead Resolution Judge in the Flood Litigation. Judge Stephens will be assisted in these mediations by The Honorable Alan D. Moats and The Honorable James P. Mazzone, assigned by the Panel as Resolution Judges in the Flood Litigation. All other

requirements of the September 16, 2009 Order Governing Mediation and Mediation
Statements shall control.
