Having reviewed *Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Discovery and Rule 37(a)(4)(A) Sanctions* (Transaction ID 57747014) and *Defendant Antero Resources Corporation's Response in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Discovery and Rule 37(a)(4)(A) Sanctions* (Transaction ID 57815303) filed in *Robert Andrews, et al. v.
