**NOTICE OF HEARING REGARDING CHALLENGES TO THE CLAIMS
ADMINISTRATOR'S DETERMINATIONS OF CERTAIN CLASS MEMBER CLAIMS**

You are hereby notified the Court will hear the challenges to the Claims Administrator's determination of certain Class Member Claims at **10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 13, 2015**, in the court room located on the first floor of the **W. Kent Carper Justice and Public Safety Complex**, 301 Virginia Street, East, Charleston, West Virginia. *See Notice of Serve Only - Private* (Transaction 57845546) e-filed on September 10, 2015. The Claims Administrator is **ORDERED** to attend the hearing and be prepared to discuss his determination of Certain Class Member Claims.

Plaintiffs who submitted a challenge to the Claims Administrator's determination of their Class Member claim ("Challengers") are invited to attend and present their challenge to the Court. If a Challenger does not wish to attend the hearing on October 13, 2015, the Challenger must advise the Court in writing **no later than October 1, 2015**, that: 1) the Challenger does not plan to attend the October 13, 2015, hearing; and 2) the Challenger wants the Court to rule on

their challenge based on their written submission. The notification shall be electronically mailed to Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel Anthony J. Majestro at amajestro@powellmajestro.com. Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel shall e-file and serve all notifications on the Presiding Judges, the Mass Litigation Manager, and all counsel of record **no later than October 2, 2015**.

Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel is directed to immediately provide a copy of this Order to the Claims Administrator by electronic mail, and to all Challengers by both electronic mail and Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested. Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel is further directed to file and serve a Notice of Compliance with this Order on the Presiding Judges, the Mass Litigation Manager and all counsel of record **no later than October 2, 2015**.

It is so **ORDERED**.
