AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

COME NOW Plaintiffs, by undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 41 of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure, and Defendant Cardinal Health 414, LLC, by undersigned counsel, and represented to the Court that the Parties in the above-referenced Mass Litigation actions have agreed, pursuant to a settlement reached between the Parties, that the Parties have agreed to voluntarily dismiss with prejudice the claims against Defendant Cardinal Health in this matter.
