**ORDER**

It was previously stipulated and agreed by the parties, and ordered by the Court that all claims Plaintiffs may have against Conwood Company, L.P., National Tobacco Company, L.P., The Pinkerton Tobacco Company, Swisher International, Inc., and U.S. Smokeless Tobacco Company, and any claims Plaintiffs may have against any other Defendant based on the use of smokeless tobacco or cigars (collectively, "Smokeless Tobacco Claims"), were severed from the above-referenced proceedings. *Stipulation and Order*, entered December 3, 2001. Although it is believed by the parties that approximately 60 cases involve Smokeless Tobacco Claims, the Court has not been provided with a list of such cases or the attorneys currently representing the parties in these claims.

No later than June 27, 2016, the Court **ORDERS** counsel for all Plaintiffs who have Smokeless Tobacco Claims to file with the Court and serve on all counsel of record:

1. A list of all cases with Smokeless Tobacco Claims severed from this litigation on December 3, 2001, including each Plaintiff's name and individual civil action number.
2. A list of all attorneys currently representing Plaintiffs and Defendants in the Smokeless Tobacco Claims, including the attorney's name, law firm, telephone number, mail and email address and who each attorney represents.

The hearing scheduled for June 13, 2016 is hereby cancelled. The Court will conduct a

hearing regarding the status of the Smokeless Tobacco Claims in the Visiting Judge's Courtroom located on the 5<sup>th</sup> Floor of the Kanawha County Annex, 111 Court Street, Charleston, West Virginia at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, July 11, 2016.
