ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

The Court ordered Plaintiffs' counsel to obtain releases and file proposed orders of dismissal with prejudice for the 5 remaining Plaintiffs identified as having claims of failure to instruct regarding ventilated filter cigarettes by April 26, 2018. *Order Regarding Rulings Issued During March 23, 2018 Hearing* (Transaction ID 61883400) at p. 4. The Court advised the parties that, "[i]f Plaintiffs' counsel fails to file the proposed orders of dismissal, the Court will dismiss the 5 remaining Plaintiffs identified as having claims of failure to instruct regarding ventilated filter cigarettes with prejudice on April 27, 2018, for non-compliance with the Court's Order." *Id.*

Because Plaintiff Wanda Frazier, Civil Action No. 00-C-1185 KAN, did not comply with the Court's *Order Regarding Rulings Issued During March 23, 2018 Hearing* it is hereby **ORDERED** that the claims of Plaintiff Wanda Frazier in the above-referenced civil action are dismissed with prejudice.
