**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO ANSWER OR OTHERWISE RESPOND**

Pursuant to the Court's order dated April 18, 2016, the defendants' response to the Consolidated Amended Class Action Complaint was due June 1, 2016. (Transaction ID 58879652)

The parties advise that the plaintiffs intend to file an amended consolidated class action complaint to bring claims pursuant to the W. Va. Code § 46A-6-101, et sec. Pursuant to W.Va. Code § 46A-6-106(c), these claims could not be brought prior to the expiration of the cure 20-day period set forth therein. Pursuant to W.Va. R. Civ. Pro 15(a), West Virginia American Water Company has agreed to the amendment and Plaintiffs have agreed that defendants need not respond to the original Consolidated Amended Class Action Complaint. Accordingly, the parties propose the following amendment to the court's order:

1. The deadline for the defendants to respond to the consolidated class action complaint is extended pending the filing of an amended complaint;
2. The plaintiffs will file an amended consolidated class action complaint on or before June 6, 2016; and
3. Defendants will have thirty days from service of the consolidated amended complaint to answer or otherwise respond to the amended consolidated class action complaint.

There being no objection, it is SO ORDERED.
