ORDER HOLDING MOTION TO COMPEL IN ABEYANCE

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff, Central West Virginia Regional Airport Authority, Inc.'s *Motion to Hold Motion to Compel in Abeyance* (Transaction ID 62335354), filed on August 10, 2018. Plaintiff CWVRAA requests the Court enter an order holding in abeyance Defendant Triad Engineering, Inc.'s *Motion to Compel* (Transaction ID 62243560) filed on July 16, 2018, for a short period of time while Defendant Triad and its experts review documents recently produced by Plaintiff CWVRAA, determine which documents previously requested remain unproduced, and for the parties to meet and confer about these documents.

There being no objection, the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiff CWVRAA's motion and **ORDERS** Defendant Triad's *Motion to Compel* (Transaction ID 62243560) filed on July 16, 2018, **HELD IN ABEYANCE** for a period of 10 business days for Triad's experts to review and advise, and then a period of 10 business days for the parties to meet and confer. If the meet and confer does not

resolve all issues addressed in Defendant Triad's *Motion to Compel*, Plaintiff CWVRAA will file its Response to the *Motion to Compel* within 10 business days of the meet and confer.

It is so **ORDERED**
