ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO JOIN IN EXISTING MASS LITIGATION

On July 24, 2014, Defendants Pfizer, Inc. (“Pfizer”), including its former division Roerig, and Greenstone LLC (“Greenstone”) moved the Mass Litigation Panel (“Panel”) pursuant to West Virginia Trial Court Rule 26.09, for an Order joining all actions set forth within the *Hill, et al.* Complaint, Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149, with the existing Mass Litigation styled *In re: Zoloft Litigation*, Civil Action No. 14-C-7000, pending in the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, West Virginia. (Transaction ID 55779906) Plaintiffs in Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149, filed a response on July 25, 2014, concurring with Defendants’ motion. (Transaction ID 55785586)

Having reviewed the motion and response, and the March 5, 2014 *Amended Administrative Order* of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, and having conferred with the Panel regarding the issues presented in the *Zoloft Litigation* and the issues raised in the *H et al.* Complaint, Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149, the Court **GRANTS** the motion and **ORDERS** all actions set forth within the *H et al.* Complaint, Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149, joined with the existing Mass Litigation styled *In re: Zoloft Litigation*, Civil Action No. 14-C-7000, pending in the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, West Virginia.

The Court **ORDERS** the case files for Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149 transferred from the Circuit Court of Wayne County, West Virginia, to the Circuit Court of Kanawha County West Virginia, as soon as practicable. The case files for Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149 shall be placed with the case files for *In re: Zoloft Litigation*, Civil Action No. 14-C-7000.

All actions set forth within the *Hill, et al.* Complaint, Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149 shall be subject to electronic filing and service, **effective August 25, 2014**. To facilitate electronic filing and service, the actions set forth within the *Hill et al.* Complaint, will be **Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 WNE through 14-C-149 WNE**.

The Clerk of the Kanawha County Circuit Court is **ORDERED** to send a certified copy of this Order to The Honorable James H. Young, Jr., and to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Wayne County, West Virginia, for service on all parties in the actions set forth within the *Hill, et al.* Complaint, Wayne County Civil Action Nos. 14-C-137 through 14-C-149. The Chair of the Mass Litigation Panel and all parties to *In re: Zoloft Litigation*, Civil Action No. 14-C-7000, will be served with this Order electronically.

It is so **ORDERED**.
