**ORDER VACATING CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER
AND SCHEDULING STATUS CONFERENCE**

In light of the stay pursuant to the Rule to Show Cause issued by the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia on January 8, 2015, and the Mandate issued on May 11, 2015, the Court hereby **VACATES** the Case Management Order entered on June 24, 2014, (Transaction ID 55637257). The parties are **ORDERED** to meet and confer regarding a proposed pretrial schedule for all remaining cases. Liaison Counsel for the parties shall then file and serve a proposed, Amended Case Management Order for consideration by the Court **no later than July 10, 2015**.

A status and scheduling conference will be conducted at **9:00 a.m. on August 10, 2015**, in **Courtroom Four**, also known as the Ceremonial Courtroom, on the Second Floor of the Kanawha County Courthouse, at 409 Virginia Street, East, in **Charleston, West Virginia**. Counsel for the parties shall be prepared to discuss the status of the litigation, including whether there are pending motions that need to be resolved, their proposed Amended Case Management Order, as well as the status of other state court Zoloft litigation, and the Zoloft MDL.
