## **Co-Petitioning.....pg. 2**

- Based on records reported, Co-petitioning levels for 2014 were similar to 2011, and have decreased since 2012. Only 10 co-petitioners have been reported for 2015.
- Types of Co-petitioners are represented as follows (2010-2015): 36% - fathers, 32% - mothers, and 32% - other relationship.

## **CPS Investigation Outcomes.....pg. 3**

- On average, from 2009 to April 6, 2015, children are deemed unsafe for 15% of JA cases, according to CPS investigation reports.
- In 2014, maltreatment occurred in 17.6% of the cases reported. As of April 6, 2015, the maltreatment percentage has dropped by roughly 6% for 2015.

## **Risk Factor Reporting.....pg. 6**

- On average, from 2011 through 2014, 79% of child abuse and neglect cases reported on the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals (WVSCA) Child Abuse and Neglect (CAN) Database indicate substance abuse risk factors.
- On average, from 2011 through 2014, 44% of child abuse and neglect cases reported on the WVSCA CAN Database indicate the domestic violence risk factor.
- Keep in mind that the total count of cases excludes cases collected by the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals Child Abuse and Neglect Database that had no risk factors indicated. This research assumes all cases include one or more risk factors and, therefore, considers cases without an indicated risk factor under reported.








