Free Relatives as Parents Program legal workshop on minor guardianship and multidisciplinary treatment teams to be held in Charleston

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – The Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia is co-sponsoring a free legal workshop from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, April 9, at Christ Church United Methodist, 1221 Quarrier St., in Charleston. The workshop is a project of the Relatives as Parents Program of Mission WV.

Judge Mary Ellen Griffith of the Twelfth Family Court Circuit will discuss the topics of minor guardianship and treatment multidisciplinary treatment teams.

The workshop is for grandparents and other relatives caring for children, foster parents, attorneys, social workers, and all interested people. Continuing education credits have been approved for attorneys (5.4 MCLEs) and social workers (5 CEUs).
