HEDGESVILLE, W.Va. – Supreme Court Chief Justice Margaret L. Workman is scheduled to participate in a Girl Scout Dine-Around at 7 p.m. Friday, May 20, at a home in Hedgesville.

Dine-Arounds are informal dinners, brunches, teas, or other events for Senior and Ambassador Girl Scouts hosted by Women's Advisory Board members at their homes or businesses.
