State Law Library to hold credit card debt workshop **For immediate release Wednesday, May 18, 2011**

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – The West Virginia State Law Library will hold a free informational workshop on surviving credit card debt at 10 a.m. on Saturday, May 21.

Education Librarian Sara Thompson will explain how to order, review, and understand a credit report, correct misinformation contained in the report, deal with debt collection calls, and write effective letters to creditors. The first ten persons to register will receive a free 88-page workbook with CD-ROM published by the National Consumer Law Center.
