### **Justice Davis to attend Kanawha truancy forum**

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – Supreme Court Justice Robin Jean Davis will attend a truancy forum hosted by Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Chief Judge Louis H. “Duke” Bloom at 1 p.m. on Tuesday, April 24, in his courtroom on the fifth floor of the Kanawha County Judicial Building, 111 Court Street, Charleston.

The purpose of the forum is to discuss the ongoing efforts of Justice Davis to encourage judicial truancy programs throughout the state, and specifically, Judge Bloom’s judicial truancy program in Kanawha County. They welcome discussion about ways to improve the efforts this year and for next school year.
