New judge to be sworn in on July 2 in Marshall County

MOUNDSVILLE, W.Va. – A new circuit judge will be sworn in to a seat in the Second Judicial Circuit (Marshall, Tyler, and Wetzel Counties) in a ceremony at 3:30 p.m. Thursday, July 2, in the circuit courtroom of the Marshall County Courthouse in Moundsville.

Jeffrey D. Cramer was appointed by Governor Earl Ray Tomblin to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Mark Karl.

The new judge is a graduate of West Virginia University and West Virginia University College of Law.

He began his career as an associated at Berry, Kessler, Crutchfield & Taylor in Moundsville in 1997. He served as Marshall County's assistant prosecutor from 1999 to 2005. He was appointed prosecuting attorney in 2005 and elected to that position in 2006, 2008, and 2012.

He is a longtime Little League baseball coach, is active in the Moundsville Lions Club, and is a supporter of 4-H and Future Farmers of America.
