The Putnam County Sheriff’s Department will offer child fingerprinting and a take-home identification kit as well as a drug take-back event. Community members are encouraged to bring medications that they are no longer using to the drug take-back event.

“Kicking addiction takes a team approach. The Putnam County Adult Drug Court is excited about this opportunity to bring the Court and the community together for fun-filled day of activities,” said Putnam County Adult Drug Court Probation Officer LaKeisha Barron-Brown.

“We’re excited to be a part of this unique event, which brings together clients, their families, and community members to highlight that recovery from substance abuse is possible,” said Recovery Point Executive Director Matt Boggs.
