Video Shows WV Court System Continues to Work During Coronavirus Pandemic

For immediate release Monday, April 20, 2020

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – A short video released today shows how court employees throughout the state continue to keep the court system open and accessible to the public despite COVID-19 restrictions.

The Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia issued an Administrative Order which declared a Judicial Emergency through May 1, 2020, in all 55 counties in West Virginia because of COVID-19. Probation officers continued to supervise probationers and conduct drug tests on drug court participants. Judges, justices, administrators and support employees continued to work on emergency matters.
