
**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S
MOTION TO RECONSIDER SENTENCE**

On July 11, 2014, the Defendant pled guilty to the Felony Offenses of Conspiracy, Burglary, Murder, and Grand Larceny, as contained in Counts One, Two, Four, Six, Eight, Nine and Eleven of Felony Indictment Number 14-F-227.



14-F-227 Count Two: To the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than one nor more than fifteen, sentence to run consecutive to the sentence imposed in counts one and four,

14-F-227 Count Six: To the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than one nor more than fifteen, sentence to run consecutive to the sentence imposed in counts four, one and two,

14-F-227 Count Eight: To the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than one nor more than ten years, sentence to run consecutive to the sentence imposed in counts four, one, two and six,

14-F-227 Count Nine: to the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than one nor more than fifteen years, sentence to run consecutive to the sentence imposed in counts four, one, two, six and eight,


14-F-227 Count Eleven: to the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than one nor more than ten years, sentence to run consecutive to the sentence imposed in counts four, one, two, six, eight and nine.

And it is further **ORDERED** that the proper officer do, as soon as practicable, remove and safely convey the said **TIMOTHY PAUL SHAFER** from the South Central Regional Jail to the Department of Corrections, to be kept imprisoned and maintained in the manner prescribed by law.

WHEREUPON, the prisoner was remanded to Department of Corrections.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk send a certified copy of this Order to all counsel of record and to the Department of Corrections.




