SENTENCE O R D E R

On June 30, 2010, came the State of West Virginia, by John W. Bennett, Prosecuting Attorney for Logan County, West Virginia, Defendant Steven Daniels in person and by his attorneys Don McDaniels and Allison Dingess, Probation Officer Kim Tipton and Probation Officer Charles Brown, pursuant to the time having been previously set for sentencing on the Defendant's guilty plea to 3rd Degree Sexual Assault and Possession of a Schedule I Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver, to-wit Marijuana.

The Court noted that the Defendant had been returned from the Anthony Correctional Center for Youthful Offenders but that the full report had not yet been received and reviewed by counsel. The Court further noted that the Defendant would not be eligible for probation at this time because in the 3rd Degree Sexual Assault case in which a 14 year old female was involved as the victim, he had not yet completed his psychiatric evaluation or submitted a written aftercare plan.

The Defendant moved that he be provided with a bond. The State objected and the Court determined that the Defendant was not eligible for bond at this time for reasons set forth above and more fully set forth in the transcript of the hearing.

After listening to the argument of counsel and reviewing the file the Court made the following findings and it is ORDERED as follows:


1. The Defendant is sentenced to not less than One (1) nor more than Five (5) years in prison on his guilty plea to 3rd Degree Sexual Assault.
2. The Defendant is sentenced to Ten (10) years post supervisory release because of the nature of the crime.
3. The Defendant shall register under the sex offender registration act.
4. The Defendant shall review the rules concerning limitations on his use of computers, requirements for the registration under the sex offender registration act and specific probation rules required of a person found guilty of such a charge with the probation department.
5. The Defendant must schedule an appointment with a psychiatrist to be evaluated pursuant to the law of this State and submit that report to the Court timely as well as obtain and submit his aftercare plan to the Court in writing.
6. The Defendant shall be placed in the custody of the Sherriff of Logan County, West Virginia, for transport to the Southwestern Regional

Jail, Holden Logan County, West Virginia and to ultimately be transferred to the Department of Corrections.

The Court does hereby ORDER that the Defendant has a period of ten (10) days within which to file any objections to this Order, in writing, and if no objections are filed, then this Court Order shall remain in full force and effect.

The Court ORDERS that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a certified copy of this Order to all counsel of record, Probation Office and to the Department of Corrections.
