ORDER

On the 11th day of June, 2012, came the defendant, **KENNETH EUGENE CARTER**, having been found guilty by a jury on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012, of the felony offense of Murder in the First Degree, a provable offense as contained in Count One of said Indictment No. 11-F-692, and to the felony offense of Malicious Wounding, a provable offense as contained in Count Two of said Indictment No. 11-F-692, appeared in Court in the custody of the Sheriff, together with his counsel, Charles Hamilton and David Dawson, and also came the State of West Virginia by Charles Miller and Tera Salango, Assistant Prosecuting Attorneys in and for Kanawha County, West Virginia.

**THEREUPON**, it was demanded of the said **KENNETH EUGENE CARTER**, if anything he had or knew to say why the Court should not now proceed to pronounce the sentence of the law against him, and no valid reason being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, it is considered by the Court as follows:

**11-F-692; Ct. 1:** That the defendant, **KENNETH EUGENE CARTER**, be committed to the custody of the West Virginia Department of Corrections for the rest of his natural life.

11-F-692; Ct. 2: That the defendant, **KENNETH EUGENE CARTER**, be committed to the custody of the West Virginia Department of Corrections for an indeterminate term of not less than two (2) years nor more than ten (10) years. Said sentence to run **CONSECUTIVE** to and not concurrent with the sentence imposed by this Court in Criminal Action No. 11-F-692; Count One.

Therefore, the effective sentence date is: June 8, 2012.

It is further **ORDERED** that the proper officer do, as soon as practicable, remove and safely convey the said **KENNETH EUGENE CARTER** from the South Central Regional Jail to the custody of the West Virginia Department of Corrections, to be kept imprisoned and maintained in the manner prescribed by law.

**WHEREUPON**, the defendant was remanded to the South Central Regional Jail.


