On the 24th day of July, 2014, came the defendant, TRACIE DENNIS, together with counsel, Olubunmi T. Kusimo-Frazier, and also came the State of West Virginia by Daniel L. Holstein, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in and for Kanawha County, West Virginia, for sentencing in this matter upon the defendant's oral and written plea of guilty to the Felony offense of Embezzlement, as contained in of Felony Information Number 14-F-312(I), entered in this Court on the 25th day of June, 2014.

THEREUPON, it was demanded of the said TRACIE DENNIS, if anything she had or knew to say why the Court should not now proceed to pronounce the sentence of the law against her, and no valid reason being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, it is **CONSIDERED** and **ORDERED** by the Court that the defendant, TRACIE DENNIS, be sentenced to the penitentiary of this State for an indeterminate term of not less than one (1) nor more than ten (10) years, plus court costs.

The Court further **ORDERED** that said sentence be suspended on the 1st day of December, 2014 for a period of five (5) years probation with the following conditions:

1. Restitution in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per month;
2. A supervision fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per month; and
3. A community corrections fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per month.

A separate probation order shall follow.



And it is further ORDERED that the proper officer do, as soon as practicable, remove and safely convey the said TRACIE DENNIS, from the South Central Regional Jail to the Department of Corrections, to be kept imprisoned and maintained in the manner prescribed by law.

WHEREUPON, the prisoner was remanded to Department of Corrections.

It is further ORDERED that the Clerk send a certified copy of this Order to all counsel of record, South Central Regional Jail and the Department of Corrections.



On the 14th day of August, 2014, came the defendant, TRACIE DENNIS, in person and by counsel, Olubunmi Kusimo-Frazier and J. Timothy DiPiero, Esqs., and also came the State of West Virginia by Daniel L. Holstein, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for Kanawha County, on the Defendant's Motion for Work Release in the above-styled case.


The Court heard the evidence and FINDS that the Defendant is a suitable candidate for work release, upon specific terms and conditions. Accordingly, the Court does hereby ORDER that the Defendant shall be granted work release from the South Central Regional Jail on Monday through Friday, each day to be released at 7:00 o'clock a.m., whereupon the Defendant shall report directly to her employer, Enerfab Electric Company in Dunbar, WV. The Defendant shall not leave the premises of her employer during the day until 4:00 o'clock p.m., at which time she shall return directly to the South Central Regional Jail, no later than 4:30 o'clock p.m. The Defendant shall not make any stops while traveling to and from the jail. Should the Defendant violate the terms of this release Order, the Court may revoke this privilege of work release, and may consider not suspending the original sentence until some later time than originally ordered, to none of which the Defendant objected.

The Court further ORDERS that the net income paid to Tracie Dennis, after all lawfully required deductions are taken from her paycheck by her employer, shall be paid by the Defendant by the close of business on the following day to the Circuit Clerk of Kanawha County during this period of work release, all of which shall be first applied to restitution and not to any court costs or fees. The Adult Probation Department shall supervise the payment of these restitution costs.

The Court notes that the Defendant is in the custody of the Division of Corrections, and it is not intended that this grant of work release should serve as any impediment to the Division in its decisions regarding the timing of placement of the Defendant in a facility of its choosing.

The Court ORDERS the Clerk of this Court to forward copies of this Order to all counsel of record and to the South Central Regional Jail.


