SENTENCING ORDER

On the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2013, came Defendant in person and by counsel, Jason Goad of the Cabell County Public Defender's Office, and also came the State of West Virginia by Lauren Plymale, for sentencing upon Indictment No 12-F-444 pursuant to Defendant having been previously found guilty by a jury of his peers of various felony offenses. After having previously waived a presentence investigation and report, the Court then afforded both counsel for Defendant, and Defendant the opportunity to speak and addressed Defendant personally.

The court then pronounced sentence upon Defendant and sentenced Defendant to the Department of Corrections in the following manner:

For Count I, the Court makes the finding that the defendant used a handgun in the commission of this offense and Orders that the defendant shall be sentenced to twenty years (20) in prison.

For Count II, the Court makes the finding that the defendant used a handgun in the commission of this offense and Orders that the defendant shall be sentenced to thirty two (32) years in prison.

For Count III, the Court makes the finding that the defendant used a handgun in the commission of this offense and Orders that the defendant shall be sentenced to twenty (20) years in prison.

For Count IV, the Court makes the finding that the defendant used a handgun in the

commission of this offense and orders that the Defendant shall be sentenced to Life in prison with the recommendation of mercy.

For Count V, the Court Orders that the defendant shall be sentenced to one (1) to five (5) years in prison.

For Count VI, the Court makes the finding that the defendant used a handgun in the commission of this offense and Orders that the defendant shall be sentenced to twenty (20) years in prison.


For Count VII, the Court makes the finding that the defendant used a handgun in the commission of this offense and Orders that the defendant shall be sentenced to Life in prison with the recommendation of mercy.



For Count VIII, the Court orders that the defendant be sentenced to six (6) months in jail.

The sentences in Counts I, II, III, IV, VI, and VII, are to run consecutively and the sentences in Counts V and VIII are to run concurrently to all counts.

In addition, the defendant is hereby assessed in the amount of seventy five dollars (\$75.00), to be paid to the Circuit Clerk pursuant to 62-5-10, on each of the following counts: I, II, III, IV, V, VI, and VII. This will not be assessed on count VIII, as the conviction was not for a felony.

All of the above is hereby adjudged, ordered, and decreed on this 9 day of April, 2013.


**ARRAIGNMENT ORDER**

On this the 25th day of April, 2012, this matter came on before the Court for arraignment purposes and eligibility for assignment of legal counsel. Whereupon, the Defendant entered a plea of not guilty. Thereupon, eligibility having been determined, the Court does hereby ORDER that Jason Goad shall represent the defendant herein.

The defendant then signed a notice of the right to be present at trial and pre-trial matters, and that in the event of his/her absence therefrom, the Court would deem said absence to be a waiver of right to be present and proceed with the prosecution of this case. The Defendant then signed a waiver of extradition.

It is further ORDERED that this matter be set on the docket of this Court for pre-trial hearing on June 7, 2012 at 1:30 PM and bond shall be set at \$185,000.00 bond, with a return date of June 7, 2012 at 1:30 PM and until Final Disposition of this case.
