IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that the Honorable David M. Hammer, Judge of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit, be, and he hereby is, appointed to serve under the provisions of Rule 29 of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules from January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2029.
