### AMENDMENT TO E-FILING AND SERVICE CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER TO ADD PHARMACY CASES MASTER CASE NUMBER

On September 10, 2021, the Mass Litigation Panel severed the above-styled cases for an expedited bench trial on September 12, 2022. *Order Regarding Rulings Issued During September 10, 2021 Status Conference* (Transaction ID 66822721). To facilitate electronic filing and service in the above-styled cases, the Court hereby amends the *Electronic Filing and Service Case Management Order* (Transaction ID 63504553) entered on July 2, 2019, to add a separate Master Case File for the State of West Virginia's cases against the above-styled pharmacies.

The Court has directed File & Serve*Xpress* to structure the new Master Case File as follows:

The Pharmacy Cases Master Case file shall contain only pleadings or documents of general applicability to the State of West Virginia's Cases against the above-styled **pharmacies**, such as trial calendars, case management orders and other orders of general applicability, joint motions, notices of deposition if they are not case-specific, master pleadings, master discovery, and other similar documents.

When a document is intended to be applicable to all of the State of West Virginia's cases against the above-styled pharmacies, the document shall be styled "*In re: Opioid Litigation*, Civil Action No. 21-C-9000 PHARM", shall contain the notation "THIS DOCUMENT APPLIES TO ALL STATE CASES AGAINST PHARMACIES" and shall be filed into Case Number MC 21-C-9000 PHARM.

When a document is intended to be applicable to a specific State of West Virginia case against a pharmacy, the document shall be styled "*In re: Opioid Litigation*, Civil Action No. 21-C-9000 PHARM", shall contain the notation "THIS DOCUMENT APPLIES TO:" and the specific pharmacy case shall be listed using the initiating case number and three-letter county identifier of the case into which the document is to be filed.

All other provisions of the Court's *Electronic Filing and Service Case Management Order* (Transaction ID 63504553) remain in full force and effect.
