ORDER REGARDING OCTOBER 7, 2022, STATUS CONFERENCE

On October 7, 2022, the Mass Litigation Panel conducted a status conference regarding the cases filed against Amneal Pharmaceuticals, Inc., Amneal Pharmaceuticals LLC, Amneal Pharmaceuticals of New York, LLC, Impax Laboratories, LLC, Mylan Pharmaceuticals, Inc., Fruth Pharmacy, Inc., Bypass Pharmacy, Inc., and Rhonda's Pharmacy, LLC (collectively, "Remnant Defendants"). Having reviewed the *Remnant Defendants' Motion for Clarification of the Panel's July 12, 2022, Order* (Transaction ID 68028751) filed September 2, 2022, and the *Remnant Defendants' Objections to Discovery Commissioner's Proposed Case Management Order* (Transaction ID 68116870) filed September 16, 2022, the Panel finds many of the concerns and objections of the Remnant Defendants to be well-taken. The Panel therefore **ORDERS** Plaintiffs' counsel and counsel for the above-referenced Remnant Defendants to meet in person with Discovery Commissioner Christopher Wilkes on a date and time to be determined by the Discovery Commissioner to discuss case management and early resolution of these cases.
