AMENDMENT TO E-FILING AND SERVICE CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER TO ADD DISTRIBUTOR CASES MASTER CASE NUMBER

The Mass Litigation Panel has ordered an expedited bench trial on July 5, 2022 against Distributor Defendants AmerisourceBergen Drug Corporation, Cardinal Health, Inc., and McKesson Corporation for all City/County and Hospital Plaintiffs which have voluntarily dismissed, without prejudice, their legal claims in accordance with *State ex rel. AmerisourceBergen Drug Corp. v. Moats,* 859 S.E.2d 374 (W. Va. 2021). (Transaction ID 66992889). To facilitate electronic filing and service in these cases, the Court hereby amends the *Electronic Filing and Service Case Management Order* (Transaction ID 63504553) entered on July 2, 2019, to add a separate Master Case File for cases filed against Distributor Defendants AmerisourceBergen Drug Corporation, Cardinal Health, Inc., and McKesson Corporation.

The Court has directed File & Serve Xpress to structure the new Master Case File as follows:

The Distributor Cases Master Case file shall contain only pleadings or documents of general applicability to cases filed against Distributor Defendants AmerisourceBergen Drug Corporation, Cardinal Health, Inc., and McKesson Corporation, such as trial

calendars, case management orders and other orders of general applicability, joint motions,

notices of deposition if they are not case-specific, master pleadings, master discovery, and other

similar documents.

When a document is intended to be applicable to all cases filed against Distributor

Defendants AmerisourceBergen Drug Corporation, Cardinal Health, Inc., and McKesson

Corporation, the document shall be styled "In re: Opioid Litigation, Civil Action No. 21-C-9000

DISTRIBUTOR", shall contain the notation "THIS DOCUMENT APPLIES TO ALL

DISTRIBUTOR CASES" and shall be filed into Case Number MC 21-C-9000 DISTRIBUTOR.

When a document is intended to be applicable to a specific case against Distributor

Defendants AmerisourceBergen Drug Corporation, Cardinal Health, Inc., and McKesson

Corporation, the document shall be styled "In re: Opioid Litigation, Civil Action No. 21-C-9000

DISTRIBUTOR", shall contain the notation "THIS DOCUMENT APPLIES TO:" and the

specific distributor case shall be listed using the initiating case number and three-letter county

identifier of the case into which the document is to be filed.

All other provisions of the Court's Electronic Filing and Service Case Management

Order (Transaction ID 63504553) remain in full force and effect.
