WHEREFORE, the Court hereby **ORDERS** that the Hospital Plaintiffs' claims and causes of action in this matter shall be and hereby are **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**, and Marshall County, West Virginia, Civil Action Nos. 19-C-69 through 19-C-88, 19-C-134 through 19-C-139, and 19-C-215 through 19-C-239 are also hereby **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.

The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, West Virginia, is hereby instructed to

strike those civil actions from the Court's docket.
