The Panel adopts the parties' Joint Trial Exhibit and Witness Disclosure Stipulation, attached as Exhibit A to the parties' Joint Motion (Transaction ID 67704293). The Panel **DENIES** *Plaintiffs' Coordinator's Proposal for Use of Track 1A Trial Testimony in the Tracks 1B and 1C Trials* (Transaction ID 67696578), and the City/County Plaintiffs' variation on the proposal, as stated in the Joint Motion. The Panel **GRANTS** *Distributor Defendants' Motion to Strike the Plaintiffs' Coordinators' Proposal for Use of Track 1A Trial Testimony in the Tracks 1B and 1C Trials* (Transaction ID 67705724).
