WHEREAS, a stay of all proceedings in this case as to Rite Aid will conserve the Court's

and the Parties' resources during the period of time necessary to finalize the settlement, will not

adversely affect this action, and will not prejudice any of the Parties;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all proceedings in this case are stayed with respect

to Rite Aid only, including but not limited to all discovery taken by or against any Rite Aid

defendants, so that the Parties may finalize settlement including completion and execution of

their settlement agreement.
