AGREED DISMISSAL ORDER

On a previous day came the parties, by and through counsel, to inform the Court that all matters in controversy between the Plaintiffs with loss of consortium claims in the above-styled matters and the Defendants in this matter have been fully adjusted, compromised, settled and disbursed and therefore moved the Court to dismiss the loss of consortium claims in the above-styled matters against all Defendants, in this case, with prejudice. It is accordingly **ADJUDGED** and **ORDERED** that those Plaintiffs that have loss of consortium claims against the Defendants, as set forth in the above-styled matters, be hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** as being fully adjusted, compromised, and settled, with each party to bear its own costs and attorneys' fees. Inasmuch as these Plaintiffs' loss of consortium claims are derivative claims of the affiliated, direct claims of certain other Plaintiffs, only the loss of consortium claims of the Plaintiffs set forth in the above-styled

matters are hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**. Any and all direct claims raised in this matter shall remain on the active docket of this Court pending final distribution of the settlement proceeds payable on such direct claims after resolution of any outstanding subrogation and/or reimbursement claims.

The Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this Order to counsel of record for all parties.
