Your letter to Counsel was reviewed by the Judicial Investigation Commission at a recent meeting. In the correspondence you stated that you recently had been appointed to serve on the West Virginia Commission for National and Community Service. You asked whether such appointment would be in conflict with your employment as a family law master.

The Commission reviewed the information which you forwarded in your correspondence which explained the structure and purpose of the Commission for National and Community Service. Based upon the information you provided, it appears that the organization is one which would fall within the limitations set forth in Canon 4C(3) of the Code of Judicial Conduct. The Commission feels that there would be no conflict with your employment as a family law master based upon the information received from you.
