Dear

In a recent letter to the Judicial Investigation Commission you asked for an advisory opinion. You stated that you are currently in private practice and serve as a part-time Mental Hygiene Commissioner in County. You have served as a Commissioner since February 2006. Effective November 1, 2008, you will be employed by the County Public Defender as a felony trial attorney. You have resigned your appointment as a Mental Hygiene Commissioner effective October 31, 2008, in advance of your employment as an Assistant Public Defender. You indicated that you will not be serving as an officer, director or County Public Defender, but will be one of its employees. nonlegal advisor to the There will be no overlap between your employment by the County Public Defender and your service as a County Mental Hygiene Commissioner. You asked whether there would be any conflict between your present position as a County Mental Hygiene Commissioner and your continued service there until October 31, 2008, and your future role as an attorney for the County Public Defender beginning November 1, 2008.

After reviewing the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Commission could find nothing which would prevent you from maintaining your position as Mental Hygiene Commissioner in

County until you begin your employment with the County Public Defender's Office. Obviously, your employment as a Mental Hygiene Commissioner and as an attorney for the Public Defender could not overlap and according to your letter will not do so.
