Your request for an advisory opinion to Counsel was reviewed by the Judicial Investigation Commission at its February 26, 2016 meeting. You want to know if a member of your court staff is permitted to have a bumper sticker on his/her car that says

To address the question which you have raised, the Commission has reviewed Rules 2.12(A) and 4.1(A)(3) of the Code of Judicial Conduct. Rule 2.12(A) states that "[a] judge shall require court staff, court officials, and others subject to the judge's direction and control to act in a manner consistent with the judge's obligations under this Code." Rule 4.1(A)(3) provides that "a judge or judicial candidate shall not publicly endorse or oppose a candidate for any public office."

Based upon the foregoing, the Commission is of the opinion that your employee cannot have a bumper sticker that states on her automobile because it would constitute opposition to a candidate for public office in violation of Rule 4.1(A)(3).
