**ORDER REGARDING RULINGS ISSUED DURING
MARCH 13, 2019 STATUS CONFERENCE**

On March 13, 2019 the Court conducted a Status Conference regarding Triad Engineering, Inc.'s cross-claim for common law "bad faith" and unfair trade practices against The Travelers Indemnity Company and made the following rulings:

1. The parties shall meet and confer today to pick a trial date in January 2020. The parties shall prepare a proposed, agreed case management and scheduling order based on the January 2020 trial date, which includes a date on which the parties are prepared to conduct mediation with the Resolution Judges, a hearing date for dispositive motions and motions in limine, and a *Pitrolo* hearing in February 2020 after the trial is concluded. The parties' proposed, agreed case management and scheduling order shall be filed and served in Rich Text Format no later than March 20, 2019.
2. At the conclusion of the parties' May 6, 2019 mediation, the parties shall file and serve a report advising the Court whether the mediation has resulted in resolution of Triad's cross-claim against Travelers.
3. As required by the Court's February 1, 2017, *Order Regarding E-Filing and Service Deadlines for Responses to Motions and Replies to Responses* (Transaction ID 60144935), Triad's response to *The Travelers Indemnity Company's Request for Ruling on Portion of Motion for Summary Judgment Held in Abeyance* (Transaction ID

63057851) is due on March 26, 2019. Traveler's reply is due seven days after Triad's response is filed.

It is so **ORDERED**.
