On this day, the Court, on its own motion, proceeded to consider amendments to Rules 2.05 and 2.29 of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules. The proposed amendments were published for comment and no comments were received. The Court is of the opinion that the rule amendments should be and they are adopted.

The proposed deletions are indicated by strikethrough, and the additions to the Rules are indicated by underscoring to read as follows:

West Virginia Trial Court Rules

Rule 2. Terms of Court.

Rule 2.05. Fifth Circuit.

For the county of Calhoun on the first Tuesday in January, May, and September; <u>for the county</u> <u>of Mason on the first Tuesday in January, May, and September</u>; for the county of Jackson, on the fourth Tuesday in February, June, and October; for the county of Roane, on the fourth Tuesday in January, May, and September.

Rule 2.29. Twenty-Ninth Circuit.

For the county of Mason, on the first Monday in January, May, and September; <u>F</u>for the county of Putnam, on the first Monday in March and on the second Monday in July and November.
