**BRIEFING OF MOTIONS FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT
REGARDING DECLARATORY JUDGMENT ACTIONS**

Any motion for summary judgment regarding the declaratory judgment actions shall be filed on or before **October 1, 2013**. The motion shall be accompanied by a memorandum of law in support of the motion, and a proposed order containing detailed findings of fact and conclusions of law. The proposed order must be filed in rich text format.

Any response shall be filed on or before **October 16, 2013**.

Any reply shall be filed on or before **October 31, 2013**.

Any memorandum of law, response brief or reply brief shall not exceed twenty-five (25) pages in length, double-spaced.

The Court will hear argument on any motion for summary judgment filed in the declaratory judgment actions at **10:00 a.m. on November 15, 2013**, in **Courtroom Four**, also known as the Ceremonial Courtroom, on the Second Floor of the Kanawha County Courthouse, at 409 Virginia Street, East, in **Charleston, West Virginia**.
