ORDER REGARDING ACCOUNTING OF SETTLEMENT FUNDS

On May 27, 2010, the Panel Chair, with the advice and consent of the Panel, assigned the Honorable James P. Mazzone to serve as the Lead Judge presiding in the Mingo County Coal Slurry Litigation.

Pursuant to order entered on June 2, 2010, the Mingo County Coal Slurry Litigation and court files were transferred to the Circuit Court of Ohio County, West Virginia, and the Mingo County Coal Slurry Litigation was consolidated under the style, "*In re: Mingo County Coal Slurry Litigation*, Civil Action No. 10-C-5000, in the Circuit Court of Ohio County, West Virginia."

On June 17, 2010, the Panel ordered the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Mingo County, West Virginia, to transfer any and all settlement proceeds that were deposited into the trust account of the Clerk of the Mingo County Circuit Court, or its Official Receiver or other Official Depository as the result of any settlements of civil actions in the Mingo County Coal Slurry Litigation to the Clerk of the Ohio County Circuit Court.

The Panel further ordered the Mingo County Circuit Clerk to provide the Ohio County Circuit Clerk with a full accounting of all deposits and disbursements of such settlement proceeds while on deposit in the trust account of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Mingo County, or its Official Receiver or other Official Depository, including but not limited to any statements or balance sheets, all orders requiring disbursement of settlement funds, and a copy of all checks issued from such account pursuant to any orders of the Mingo County Circuit Court.

The Clerk is hereby ORDERED to provide the Court, counsel for Plaintiffs, and counsel for Defendants with a full accounting of all deposits and disbursements of all settlement proceeds that were deposited into the trust account of the Clerk of the Ohio County Circuit Court, or its Official Receiver or other Official Depository as the result of any settlements of civil actions in the Mingo County Coal Slurry Litigation, including but not limited to any statements or balance sheets, all orders requiring disbursement of settlement funds, and a copy of all checks issued from such account pursuant to any orders of this Court.
