C. Richard Wilson To Be Sworn In On March 13

MOUNDSVILLE, W.Va. – Marshall County attorney C. Richard Wilson will be sworn into office as a judge in the Second Judicial Circuit (Marshall, Tyler, and Wetzel Counties) at 4 p.m. on Monday, March 13, in the Marshall County Courthouse Circuit Court Courtroom.

Governor Jim Justice appointed him on February 1 to fill the seat vacated by the resignation of Judge David Hummel, Jr., on November 23, 2022.

Mr. Wilson is a lifelong resident of Marshall County who has a bachelor's degree (1988) and law degree (1991) from West Virginia University. In his 30-year legal career, he has been in private practice and served as a Marshall County Assistant Prosecutor, a fiduciary commissioner, and a mental hygiene commissioner.

He and his wife, Jill, live in Moundsville and have four children.
