AMENDED NOTICE OF STATUS CONFERENCE

On September 1, 2023, the Court entered a Consent Judgment in *State of West Virginia* ex rel. Patrick Morrisey, Attorney General v. The Kroger Co., et al., Civil Action No. 22-C-111 PNM (Transaction ID No. 70766802), dismissing with prejudice the State of West Virginia's claims against Kroger, and also dismissing with prejudice the claims of all Litigating Local Governments that have been asserted against Kroger in actions pending before this Court, as shown in Exhibit B to the Consent Judgment as to Kroger. On September 5, 2023, the Court

entered a Notice of Consent Judgment as to Kroger (Transaction ID 70781141), which was

served on all counsel of record in the Opioid Litigation. Accordingly, Kroger is excused from

attending the status conference scheduled to be conducted in the above-captioned cases at 11:00

a.m. on September 15, 2023, in the Courtroom located on the 11th Floor of the West Virginia

The parties in State of West Virginia ex rel. Patrick Morrisey, Attorney General v.

Walgreens Boots Alliance, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 20-C-82 PNM, are required to attend the

status conference at 11:00 a.m. on September 15, 2023, and be prepared to explain their delay in

submitting their proposed consent judgment order inasmuch as this litigation is on hold pending

entry of a consent judgment order as to Walgreens. See Order Regarding Common Benefit Fund

Commissioner's Recommendation Regarding Attorney Fees and Expenses (Transaction ID

70016850) entered on May 15, 2023 ("[F]ifteen (15) days after all consent judgment orders

and/or dismissal orders have been entered by the Court, the Common Benefit Fund

Commissioner shall file a recommendation regarding attorney fees and expenses ").
