The moving party shall thereafter have 10 days to file a rebuttal memorandum, if desired. Thereafter, the Court will rule upon the motion on the pleadings and record or schedule a hearing if the Court deems it necessary.

Copies of the proposed orders and the original motions and memoranda shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court.
