## ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT SMITH/PACKETT MED-COM, LLC, SP WV, LLC AND WV IL-AL INVESTORS, LLC's MOTION FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER

On April 5, 2021, this matter came before the Court pursuant to Rule 26(c) of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure and Defendant Smith/Packett Med-Com, LLC, SP WV, LLC and WV IL-AL Investors, LLC's Motion for a Protective Order from Mountain State Pipeline & Excavating, LLC's Requests for Admission. The Court has reviewed the Motion and Finds and Orders as follows:

- On November 6, 2020, MSPE filed a First (1<sup>st</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission to Smith/Packett Defendants, containing 84 requests.
- Per the Certificate of Service, Smith/Packett Defendants responded to the First
   (1<sup>st</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission, on December 9, 2020.
- 3. On November 13, 2020, MSPE filed a Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission, containing 34 requests.
- Smith/Packett Defendants responded to the Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission on December 16, 2020.
- 5. On December 7, 2020, MSPE filed a Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission, containing 20 requests.
- 6. Smith/Packett Defendants responded to the Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission on January 6, 2021.
- 7. On December 15, 2020, MSPE filed a Fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Set of Requests for Admissions, containing 19 requests.
- 8. Smith/Packett Defendants responded to the Fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission on January 14, 2021.

- 9. On February 23, 2021, MSPE filed a Fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission, containing 81 requests.
- 10. MSPE has filed a total of 238 requests for admission to Smith/Packett

  Defendants. Smith/Packett Defendants have responded to all but the last set,
  leaving 81 requests unanswered and subject to the requested Protective Order.
- 11. The Court finds that pursuant to Rule 26(b)(1) and Rule 26(c), MSPE's requests for admission to Smith/Packett Defendants are excessive, duplicative and some can be found in referenced documents.

## It is, therefore, ADJUDGED and ORDERED:

- 1. That Smith/Packett Defendants' Motion for a Protective Order from Mountain State Pipeline & Excavating, LLC's Fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) Set of Requests for Admission is hereby GRANTED.
- That Smith/Packett Defendants are relieved of the burden to respond to MSPE's Requests for Admissions, Set 5.
- 3. That the Court will allow MSPE to resubmit to Smith/Packett Defendants no more than 30 Requests for Admissions, in addition to the previously answered requests by Smith/Packett Defendants.

All accordingly which is ORDERED and DECREED.
