AGREED ORDER

On this day came the parties, by counsel, and jointly represented to the Court that they have agreed to modify the expert witness disclosure deadlines established by the Court's Scheduling Order entered on March 8, 2021. The Court directs the Clerk to send a copy of this Order to counsel of record.




